 Wagon, a cart, three Bar shear ploughs, two shone  
 ploughs, one Harrow, one Feather Bed, one Bureau one  
 Table, six Chairs five Iron Pots, one Iron Pan all my  
 Crop of Corn one pair Shovel & Tongs one pair of and  
 Irons, one Kitchen Cupboard and contents, with all my  
 personal property, all of which property is now in my  
 possession. To have and to hold the said property, to  
 the said John Hart his executors, administrators and  
 assigns forever. And I the said Gabriel Thomas for  
 my heirs, executors, and administrators, the aforesaid  
 property, to the said John Hart his executors, admin-  
 istrators and assigns, against him the said John Hart  
 his executors and administrators, and against every  
 person and all persons whatever shall and will  
 warrant and forever defend by these presents, provided  
 nevertheless, that in case I the said Gabriel Thomas  
 shall pay and satisfy to the said John Hart or to his  
 executors, administrators or assigns, the sum of one  
 hundred & twenty eight dollars current money, with  
 interest for the same, on or before the 28th day of  
 November next ensuing, then this bill of sale and every  
 matter and thing therein expressed, shall be void and  
 of none effect, it being the true intent and meaning  
 thereof, that the said property is mortgaged by me  
 the said Gabriel Thomas to be repaid to the said John  
 Hart the payment of the money aforesaid. In witness  
 whereof, I the said Gabriel Thomas have hereunto  
 set my hand and affixed my seal, the 28th day of  
 October in the year eighteen hundred and twenty five  
 signed sealed and delivered

in presence of } Gabriel <sup>his</sup> Thomas (Seal)  
 which was thus <sup>made</sup> entered, to wit, on this 28th day  
 of October 1825, before me one of the Justices of the  
 peace in and for said County, personally appeared  
 Gabriel Thomas and acknowledge the foregoing  
 writing to be his act and deed according to the  
 true intent and meaning, thereof, and the act  
 of assembly, in such case made and provided,
