 alien release, confirm and reconvey to the said  
 Mercer, the said one hundred and eighty three acres  
 of the Hope Lands aforesaid. To have and to  
 hold, the said one hundred and eighty three acres  
 of the Hope Lands, with all and singular its  
 appurtenances unto him the said Mercer and his  
 heirs forever, to the same extent of Interest and  
 title as if the said deed of Mortgage dated the  
 seventeenth day of August eighteen hundred and  
 eighteen had never been executed by the said
